WHAT IS THE NEXT RATOON PROGRAM?

NEXT RATOON is CANEGROWERS Mentoring Program.

WHAT IS MENTORING?

It's more than regular catch ups over a coffee that's for sure. It's actually a master skill and art form all rolled into one. It's learning how to show up, how to question, how to give and receive honest feedback, how to create and envisage a plan for the future and break it down into meaningful and manageable steps.

WHAT WILL I LEARN ON HOW TO BE A GREAT MENTOR?

If you engage in the NEXT RATOON mentoring program as a mentor, you'll be trained to play a pivotal role in transforming the thinking of the people you coach. This program is aimed at incorporating psychological theory and practice to provide you with skills, tools, tips and strategies for making the process of mentoring easier.

You will be involved in a two-day program alongside the NEXT RATOON mentee's in February 2024. Then you will be provided with monthly videos and tools to keep your mentoring sessions on track. Additional support and accountability is also provided on a monthly basis.



HOW DO I BECOME A MENTOR?

We are seeking mentors who are interested in playing a pivotal role in the NEXT RATOON program:

1. Experience that is relatable to agriculture

Broad experience preferably with agricultural leadership in areas such as production, marketing or business management.

2. An enthusiasm to share and learn

Open to learning new skills and applying the program material in their interaction with their mentee to create a positive learning experience.

3. Encourage diversity of opinions

Open to different perspectives and have a willingness to listen to mentees' ideas and perspective.

4. Invested in success

Committed to allocating the time needed to help mentees succeed.

WHAT'S THE COMMITMENT?

NEXT RATOON has a time commitment of approximately 4 hours per month and includes:

- Attending the NEXT RATOON event in Brisbane on 27 and 28 February 2024.
- Monthly mentoring session with your mentee of at least 1 hour per month (either face-to-face or virtual catch-up) for six months.
- Accessing online learning modules between the months of February and August, 2024. This is content to help you with your mentoring role.
- A monthly virtual check-in session with the Pragmatic Thinking team.
- Attendance at the NEXT RATOON wrap up event in August in Brisbane.



The learning modules will be made available to you online so you can engage with the learning in your own time.

In terms of the mentoring commitment to your mentee; when you connect and how you catch-up for mentoring will be determined by what works best for both of you.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT FROM ENGAGING IN THE MENTORING LEARNING EXPERIENCE?

You will receive materials at the start of every month between March – August. You will also be able to connect with the team at Pragmatic Thinking for any trouble-shooting. You can expect the following experience from the NEXT RATOON program:

- A highly engaged and purposeful mentoring relationship.
- The development of a solid set of skills to assist you with mentoring conversations in your own leadership practice or workplace.
- Progress on goals and markers set by mentee for their own leadership development and industry input.

You will require internet access as the course will be delivered via email and can be accessed through mobile devices or desktop. Any learning resources or worksheets provided, can be either printed or filled in electronically.
